This external assessed (exam) component builds on knowledge, understanding and skills acquired and developed in Components 1 and 2. Students will be given a case study and will assess an individual's health and wellbeing, drawing on their understanding of life events from Component 1. They will design a health and wellbeing improvement plan that draws on their knowledge of services and care values from Component 2.
