### Year 11 Prefect Application 2022-23

We are looking forward to welcoming applications from students who would like to become a year 11 Prefect for the 2022-23 academic year. Prefects will hold the most senior of student leadership responsibilities within the Academy and will be led by two Lead Prefects and two Deputy Lead Prefects.

Being a Prefect is a great way to give back to the Academy, but also to get more out of it. Prefects undertake a huge responsibility and honour on behalf of the Academy, which benefits not only themselves but the wider Academy. As such, we are looking for incredibly high standards of discipline, punctuality, commitment and maturity. Above all, a strong Prefect is highly motivated and ready to give up some of their time, across a range of duties and responsibilities. Prefects will be involved in making decisions that will have an impact across the Academy, so students will need to be able to demonstrate good decision-making skills, resilience and be a role model for the nine habits.

Students will help set the tone of the Oasis Academy Brislington ethos in the Academy on a daily basis, and in the wider community or public events. Prefects will not be expected to implement the culture for learning policy with students but would be expected to set a good example at all times to other students, and help teachers maintain the student charter of **work hard, look smart, be nice and be safe**. Prefects will be recognised by their black ties. Invitations to parents / carers of successful applicants for the celebration assembly will be sent out at the end of March.

We invite you to read the information attached to understand what we are looking for. Students will need parent / carer consent and the support of a member of staff for their application. If their application progresses to the next stage, they may be interviewed in a group setting by staff and members of the Student Academy Council. We are accepting 34 applicants onto the Prefect team from April 2022 until April 2023. Further information on the prefect positions is detailed in the attached Prefect Application Form.
