Dear Parent/Carer

You may be aware from media coverage that the National Education Union has declared strike action, which will take place on Wednesday 1st February, Thursday 2nd March, Wednesday, 15th March and Thursday 16th March. The strike is happening because of a national dispute between the unions and the government over teachers' pay, and not because of any issues at our academy.

We are getting in touch to give you as much notice as possible that learning may be disrupted on these dates. At this stage we are considering several options. As you will know, we are only able to open the school if we have a sufficient number of staff to keep everyone safe.

Whilst we are not yet in a position to confirm whether the academy will be open on 1st February (and the subsequent strike dates), please start to think about alternative childcare arrangements for these dates.


